Outdoor Gathering Guidelines, a/o 10/2020

- Decide (as a group or host) if this event is best held in person or on Zoom.
- Meetings held at the UUSS campus are to be held outdoors until further notice.
- Minimum/Maximum number of attendees: 3 10
- RSVP's are required, with adult attendees confirming they will abide by these guidelines.
 The Host is responsible for sharing the UUSS guidelines at the time of the invitation as well as adherence during the gathering.
- Reservations must be made with the church office.
- The host takes responsibility for sanitizing UUSS' tables and chairs before and after the meeting.
- Touchless Thermometer, provided by UUSS, to be used as people enter the venue for the gathering. Host is responsible for validating attendees' temperature, current health, and possible COVID-19 exposure with a form to be provided by the church.
- Face coverings are mandatory at all times, per the Governor, except for kids 2 years old and younger.
- Physical distancing rules must be followed and will be enforced by host. Six feet of distance is required between all attendees.
- Host to keep list of attendees, with contact information, and submit the list to office staff after each gathering.
- There will be no food/drink other than a drink/snack each person brings for themselves.
- Ensure access to the restroom with the office staff when planning event.
- Ensure availability of sanitizer wipes in the restroom to wipe down faucet, handles, and
 other fixtures after they have been touched. Inform attendees to wipe all fixtures they
 touch after they use the restroom. Signage is in the restroom with appropriate
 instructions.
- These guidelines will be updated as necessary.
